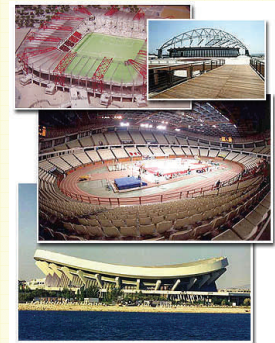

- **Providing technical & operational expertise** of integrated command & control systems, public order and surveillance systems such as CCTV

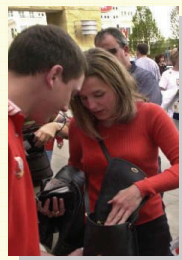
### Fraud Awareness
